



INFLATABLE SAFETY OPERATIONS



WEATHER CONDITIONS

When it comes to weather, its so unpredicable so you need to be alert. Observe the clouds and wind speed, you can do this by using the anemometer and a wind radar app. Make sure to record the wind speeds every 30 minutes during usage. If wind speeds exceed 32kmph or wind speeds on the app are suggesting gusts of over 35kmph, then please safely evacuate the inflatable and turn of the blower. Monitor the wind speed every 5 minutes and once a time of 30 minutes has passed without gusts of 32kmph or more, you can begin to use the inflatables again. You can do this by turning the blowers back on. Before you let anyone use the inflatables, make sure that everything is as it should be, that no weights/pegs have moved and that all areas are safe.

NUMBER OF KIDS

Most of our inflatables are kicking or throwing activations, so make sure to take it in turns. For those that aren't, such as our jumping castles and/or obstacle courses, please ensure you do not overload them and that a competent adult is watching them at all times. If for any reason the person monitoring the activity needs to leave, please evacuate the inflatable and turn off the blower.

Our castles are rated for 6 children at anyone time, our obstacle courses are designed to encourage a race, a 2 per time, most other activations are 1 at a time. If you are unsure, please call 0477499740.

MOVING THE EQUIPMENT

Please do not move the equipment. The equipment is either pegged or weighted for safety. If in an emergency you need to move the equipment, please contact 0477499740. Note, efforts will be made to move equipment in emergencies for multi day hires, due to scheduling and work load, single day hires will be forfeited if the equipment needs to be moved, unless otherwise discussed.

GET TO KNOW YOUR AREA

When it comes to ensuring your vision is clear, you have to think about the world from a child's perspective. How small are they, where would they hide, what would they do. It's important that you scan your vision radar, and note any blind spots. You may need to move throughout the day to efficiently monitor the inflatables.

While monitoring customer behaviour and safety, you also need to remember to check the inflatable is secure, at all times... Including before and after a shift, as well as during. You also need to visually check the power cords, ensuring they are not a trip hazard or at risk to visitors.

WATER QUALITY

When it comes to water quality, if something doesn't look right, it usually isn't. It's important to consider the following:

- Is the filtration too close to the water's edge
- Is there any debris in the water
- Is the water clear
- Does the water need to be sanitised

Maintaining the pools can be difficult, ask for help if you need it
